In addition to written assignments, students should read and study on a daily basis in order to keep up with the rigorous class material.

### **Late Work Policy**

Students need to submit assignments on the date that they are due in the beginning of

each class period. Late work is highly discouraged. If due to an emergency or extenuating circumstance an assignment is not submitted on time, 10% of the grade will be deducted for every day that the assignment is late--this includes weekends and holidays. The teacher will determine the last day that the assignment may be submitted in accordance with the unit being taught. It will no longer be considered an emergency or extenuating circumstance if there is a pattern of late submission of assignments.

Its emphasis is on the cultures of Southwest Asia (Middle East), Africa, Central Asia, East Asia Southeast Asia and Europe. The host nation culture is studied and used as a basis of comparison.
